- 11 A plate of 3 scones (gentlemen only)
- 12 A homemade pate
- 13 A tea loaf
- 14 A homemade roulade
- 15 A jar of homemade lemon curd
- 16 A jar of homemade jam
- 17 A bottle of homemade white wine *Staffordshire Knott Trophy (wine)*
- 18 A bottle of homemade red wine

### Home-grown Produce *Blue Circle Rose Bowl*

- 19 3 white eggs
- 20 3 brown eggs *The Grindon Herd Trophy (eggs)*
- 21 A specimen egg
- 22 6 runner beans
- 23 5 potatoes on a plate (washed)
- 24 1 bowl of summer fruit (without leaves)
- 25 *Manifold Top Tray Novice class:* A collection of 3 types of vegetables from the following (3 onions, 3 potatoes, 3 carrots, 3 tomatoes, 6 runner beans, 3 beetroot, 6 peas, 2 lettuce, 2 cucumbers, 3 peppers) on a tray or board approximately 12" x 18".

Higher points awarded to eggs that match in size & shape, and that are 'egg shaped', not elongated or oval.

### For Younger People, 15 years and under on Show day *Presidents Shield*
